MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
SOUTHEASTERN REINING HORSE ASSOCIATION
September 22, 2009
Hibachi Grill and Buffet, Smithfield, NC

Roll Call - Present were: Jesse Chase, Diane Ireland, Joy Frannicola, Wendy Workman, Christy Langdon, Cindy Langdon, Bundy Lane, Ruffin Johnson, Jimmy Whitley, Monica Watson, Allison Lassiter and Martin Audet. Also present were Mike Hancock and Kelly Jo Hopkins. Excused were: Daniel Blackburn, Beryl Keith, Kit Cosper, Peter DeFreitas, Eric LaPorte

Call to Order – The meeting was called to order by Vice President Jesse Chase following a Prayer led by Ruffin Johnson.

Committee Reports – Diane gave the Treasurer’s Report and indicated that after paying the bills for the Ag Center, the USEF and the donation towards the Regional Directors’ travel fund, we still have funds on hand, which will be needed to fund SERHA’s portion of the RAF show. We also have a bill due to be paid to NRHA for trophies. Diane has been collecting past due receivables from the Celebration Books (2008 and 2009) and she will be invoicing 2009 sponsors for their pledges. Joy moved to accept the Treasurer’s Report and Ruffin seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Allison gave us an update on the awards for the RAF/Carolina Fall Classic show. After discussions with Mike, they agreed to award leather collar denim jackets to the first place winners at the show. Because of sizing issues, jackets will be ordered for the winners, instead of being handed out at the show. There will be enough on hand to award to the winners of the affiliate classes at the show. The cost of the jackets was well within our stated budget, the price included a one-time setup charge for the embroidery. The jackets will feature the Carolina Fall Classic logo on back, with lettering on the front – “S.E. Affiliate Championship”. Other prizes to be awarded will include vendor-donated items. Allison mentioned that she spoke with Sherry Wayne about what was awarded last year – Sherry mentioned that each of the affiliates donated free stalls (no bedding) at their future shows. The Board Members present thought this was a great idea, and the list of affiliates was split so members could call and solicit stall donations.

While on the subject of the Fall Classic/RAF show, our hospitality contributions were discussed. The Hospitality Committee is made up of Jesse, Diane, Wendy and Kelly Jo. We will host an ice-cream social on Thursday nite, with the location (tentatively) to be the Farrier’s Barn. Kelly reported that Schwartz will donate the ice cream. We will also sponsor coffee/donuts during the late nite/early morning hours (when the concession stand is closed). Diane will call Food Lion about donating the coffee and donuts. This will be during the Thursday and Friday evening/early morning hours. Wendy and Lisa Matthews have offered to help with the coffee detail. We’re planning a BBQ for Friday nite. Bundy has offered to donate the burgers. We will have burgers and hot dogs, with assorted side dishes and salads. The BBQ Committee is Bundy, Jimmy, Wendy and Ruffin. Mike Hancock said that he would handle the Breakfast on Sunday morning. Jesse moved to accept the Committee Reports, Wendy seconded the motion. All were in favor, the motion passed.

Update on RAF Show/Carolina Fall Classic – The schedule for the Carolina Fall Classic and RAF show has been posted on both the SERHA website and on the Carolina Classic Derby website. There will be 3 slates of classes plus the futurity classes – 2 sets of ancillary classes; 1 set of affiliate classes and the futurity classes.

Mike indicated that Linda Raymond would be in charge of the Youth Team Tournament – she would need volunteers to help assemble and distribute the prizes. Cindy and Christy Langdon offered to help, and Kelly Jo said she would be there as well. Tables would need to be assembled and prizes distributed. Allison Lassiter would be the contact person. There will be a pizza/sub party late on Saturday afternoon, during the Youth Meeting.

Regarding the prizes for the Youth awards, Mike reported we have corporate sponsors for placings 1 through 5; we need additional sponsors for 6th through 10th places. Mike suggested that instead of giving ribbons, towels would be awarded.

The Show Office will be ready to handle on-site questions at the show. There will also be T-shirts and hoodies for sale at the show office.

Since it is Halloween weekend, all exhibitors will be reminded to bring candy – we will try to arrange an organized “trick or treat” session for the youngsters on Saturday. Decorating your stalls will be an option – there will not be a stall decorating contest. Joy will send an email to all members with this information.

Mike also suggested adding a line item to the show bill, giving exhibitors an opportunity to donate to the Reining Horse Sports Foundation Crisis Fund. Everyone agreed this was a good idea.

New Business – Changes to the Sponsorship Package were discussed by those Board Members present. Joy will revise the package to reflect the suggested changes and circulate it among the Board Members for approval. Diane will furnish the ad rates for the Celebration Book, to be included as a separate sponsorship vehicle.

A Finance Committee was formed to pursue collection of past due receivables, invoicing of current sponsorship pledges and to keep track of all pledges. The Committee will be Diane and Joy, with help from Jesse.

A Nominating Committee for the 2010 Board of Directors was formed. The Committee is responsible for coming up with a slate of officers to be elected, as well as new Board Members. The members of the Committee are Jesse, Ruffin and Bundy. Wendy and Monica discussed coming up with an actual listing of Board Member responsibilities (to include volunteering at our shows)

Our By-Laws need to be revised to stay current with the NRHA By-Laws. Several suggested changes include the establishment of a quorum of Board Members to be present at meetings, and the adoption of Roberts Rules of Order to govern meetings. By-Laws revisions are to be voted on by the general membership. The suggested changes must be presented to the general membership 30-days prior to our General Membership Meeting. The By-Laws revision committee is Jesse, Allison and Joy. All Board Members were asked to review the existing By-Laws and to suggest changes.

Jesse mentioned that the Board Members need to make themselves available to the General Membership, in an effort to show our Affiliate as being “member-friendly”. Joy suggested that each Board Member submit a picture of themselves, to be posted on the website. This way, the members will recognize the Board Members when they see them at a show.

Jesse went through a listing of potential sponsors for the 2010 season, and several Board Members offered to be contact persons. We need to have the Sponsorship Package in place before anyone is contacted about sponsoring a class or show next year. Ruffin raised the question of renting space to display a banner – not as a part of our sponsorship package, but in addition to the package. Several ways to do this would be to sell space at both SERHA shows, with a location to be determined. It was agreed to table this topic for future discussion.

Kelly suggested giving the sponsors a plaque or certificate so they can display it in their offices. This would show our appreciation in ways other than to just announce their names at a show. A suggestion was also made to include a “sponsorship” line item on show bills, giving exhibitors an opportunity to donate when they settle their account. This was also tabled for future discussion.

Ruffin moved to accept all of the new business reports, Bundy seconded the motion, all present were in favor and the motion passed.

Jesse said that we would need to schedule a meeting in the near future (November) to discuss the Spring Show and to get the Sponsorship Packages out to the membership. We also need to meet to review the proposed By-Laws revisions. Jesse moved to adjourn the meeting, Bundy seconded the motion. All present were in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
